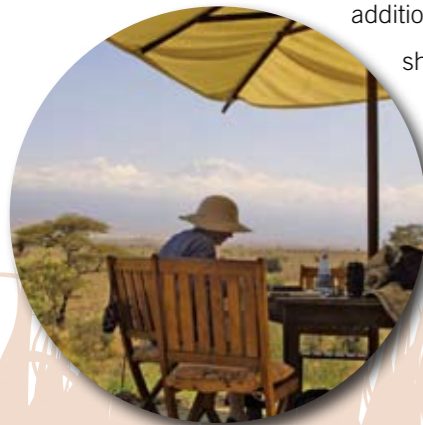
Experience
